# "PAUL'S LAST WORDS"

Text: II Timothy 4:9-22

Subject: How To Deal With Friends And Foes In The Ministry

# Introduction

- 1. Paul writes this final letter (II Timothy) in his darkest hour.
- 2. Paul is a prisoner in Rome, facing certain death. (II Timothy 4:6)
- 3. Nearly 100 different friends and fellow laborers are named in Acts and Paul's letters, but now only Luke is at his side. (II Timothy 4:11)

Question: Why is Paul writing this letter?

**Answer**: Because Paul's great concern is not for himself, but for the success of the gospel.

- Paul encourages Timothy to be faithful.
- Paul sends Tychicus to replace Timothy at Ephesus so that Timothy might join Paul at Rome. (II Timothy 4:9,12)
- God will soon take Paul off the scene and Timothy will give spiritual leadership to the churches.

**Question**: What does Paul talk to Pastor Timothy about? **Answer**: Real life issues that affect us all:

- In Chapter 1, ministers must deal with their...
  - 1. Enthusiasm (Vs. 1-7) 2. Suffering (Vs. 8-12) 3. Faithfulness (Vs. 13-18)
- In Chapter 2, the minister is a ...
  - 1. Steward (Vs. 1-2)
  - 2. Soldier (Vs. 3-4)
  - 3. Athlete (Vs. 5)

- 4. Farmer (vs. 6-7)
- 5. Workman (Vs. 14-18)
- 6. Vessel (Vs. 19-22)
- 7. Servant (Vs. 23-26)
- In Chapter 3, obedience in perilous times of ministry includes...
  - 1. Turning from the false. (Vs. 1-9)
  - 2. Following those who are true. (Vs. 10-12)
  - 3. Continuing in the Word. (Vs. 13-17)
- In Chapter 4, last words to every minster...
  - 1. How to preach the Word at all times. (Vs. 1-4)
  - 2. How to make full proof of your ministry. (Vs. 5-8)
  - 3. How to deal with friends and foes. (Vs. 9-22)

**Question**: What does God address through Paul at the end of Paul's life? **Answer**: Some nuts and bolts about "Ministerial Relationships"

# (Things Like)

- How to be good when other people are bad.
- How to stay sweet when you're tempted to get sour.
- How to deal with friends and foes throughout life's journey.

# (Incredible Secrets from Paul's Final Hours)

# I. God Knows We Can't Do It Alone!

*"Do thy diligence to come shortly unto me."* (V. 9) *"Take Mark and bring him with you, for he is profitable to me for the ministry."* (V. 11)

◆ Paul was incredibly used of God (and) ◆ Paul knew a great life of power and ministry.

# (Yet Paul Says)

"Only Luke is with me, hurry up and bring me my companion, Timothy, I'm lonely."

**Question**: What's the lesson here from God?

Answer: The lesson is; Paul never reached a plane of not needing other people!

#### The Lesson Is Clear

- 1. Unless we can get along with other people, we will live a lonely and unproductive life.
- 2. Unless we are healthy and secure, we will isolate ourselves from the team around us.
- 3. Unless we crucify our <u>pride</u>, we will reject all advice, correction and strength that surrounds us.

(Proverbs 27:5) "Open rebuke is better than secret love." (And)

(Proverbs 11:14) "In the multitude of counselors there is safety."

# (Remember)

*"If you can't get along with other people it is the kiss of death, because people are all we have to work with."* (Lee lacocca)

"Differences of opinions are okay, bad attitudes are not okay; it's not your position but your disposition that gives you influence." (John Maxwell)

# II. God Knows That Your Heart Will Be <u>Broken</u>!

♦ In verse 10, "Demas has deserted me."

♦ In verse 14, "Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil."

# (Paul Is Saying Here)

- "Demas used to love God and me, but has turned away."
- "Alexander the metal worker was harmful to me."
- "Even Crescens and Titus were called away to Galatia and Dalmatia." (V. 10)

# (The Lesson Is Clear)

 People will let you down, people will disappoint you and some will even hurt you on purpose.

# (The Life Application Is)

Love people fervently, but always keep your expectations in the Lord.

# (Psalm 62:5)

"My soul wait thou only upon God, for my expectation is from Him."

# (Jeremiah 17:5)

"Cursed is the man that trusts in man and makes flesh his arm, and whose heart departs from the Lord."

# (And If Your Heart Has Been Broken)

"God heals the broken heart and binds up their wounds." (Psalm 147:3)

# (And Remember)

- Answer your critics with your <u>life</u> and not your <u>words</u>!
- Learn to wrestle with <u>God</u> in secret and you'll never lower yourself to wrestle with <u>man</u> in public.
- If you don't get healed (after you've been hurt) you'll injure others all along the way.

# III. God Has An Escape Hatch From Internal Destruction!

"At my first answer no man stood with me, but all men forsook me; I pray God that it may not be laid to their charge." (V. 16)

<u>Question</u>: What protected Paul from internal destruction, a sour spirit, carnal planning, withdrawing from people and a defensive non-trusting disposition?

**<u>Answer</u>**: The escape hatch called <u>forgiveness!</u>

(In V. 14) "The Lord reward Alexander according to his evil." (Means)

- Not that Paul was praying for judgment to fall upon Alexander the metal worker.
- But that Paul was leaving Alexander in the hands of the Lord to work it out His way.

#### (In Other Words)

- Paul doesn't rehearse how to get even with his foes.
- Paul doesn't keep <u>score</u> of wrong doing against him.
- Paul doesn't feel good about justice upon his enemies.

#### **Instead Paul Says:**

 "My fellow minister, be a good forgiver and let God be the one who rewards and repays those who hurt you!"

# Notice The Power Of Verse11

"Take Mark and bring him to me now."

- In Acts, John Mark had deserted Paul in the journey.
- But now, Paul extends grace to the one who had failed him previously.

#### Paul Says:

"Timothy, go get Mark, God wants to use him, hurry up and bring him to me"

- "I know we haven't seen eye to eye."
- "I know we didn't get along before."
- "I know we've had heated discussions."
- "I know we parted ways in the past."

#### What A Discovery Here:

- That God has a way to restore friendships!
- That restored relationships can be some of the sweetest!
- The God restores through the power of a forgiving spirit!

# Proverbs 13:10 "Only by pride cometh contention"

# **Remember**

 "Unforgiveness is the <u>poison</u> we drink while we wait for the other person to die." (Dr. Don Meyer)

- "An enemy in the heart is worse than 10,000 in the field."
- "Our offenses will either be our <u>tombstone</u> or our <u>stepping</u> stone; it all depends on our choice."
- "The only part of me that can be offended is that part of me which has not died.

# IV. God Reserves Some Secrets Only For <u>Himself</u>!

"Erastus abode at Corinth, but Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick." (V. 20)

- Trophimus was from Ephesus and a friend of Tychicus. (Acts 20:4)
- Trophimus was with Paul when the riot was ignited in Jerusalem (Acts 21:28-29)
- Trophimus had been serving at Miletus, but now he is seriously ill.

# Question: What does Scripture say here?

**Answer**: That a faithful minister gets sick.

**Question**: Why wasn't Trophimus healed? (Paul prayed for others who were healed) **Question**: Why don't we know why some are healed and some are not?

#### Because...

- Some things are just plain unexplainable and,
- Some things we must simply leave in the eternal chambers of God.
- Some secrets God has kept only for Himself.

# Truth Be Known:

- "All things work together for good." (Romans 8:28)
- "As for God, His way is perfect." (Psalm 18:30)
- "My grace is sufficient for you." (II Corinthians 12:9)
- "He makes all things beautiful in His time." (Ecclesiastes 3:11)

# Remember

"When you cannot trace God's hand, you can always trust His heart!"

# V. God Is Always <u>Present</u> Even When No One Else Is!

In verse 16, "All men forsook me." (Yet) In verse 17, "Notwithstanding, the Lord stood with me and strengthened me."

# In Other Words

"I looked around and no one was there to befriend me - except the Lord!"

# In Fact

1. "He stood with me (and)2. He strengthened me.

**Question**: What is Paul telling Pastor Timothy? **Answer**: That God is with you when no one else is (and that my friend is enough)!

- Question: Why did Paul receive such strength from God?
- **Answer**: Verse 17 "That by me (or through me) the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear."

# In Other Words

 Paul has no personal agenda – all that matters is that the gospel be heard and God's kingdom be increased.

# The Lesson Is Clear

 That God will stand with you and strengthen you supernaturally to the degree that you want to do <u>His will</u> and not your own.

# Let's Pray This Continually:

"Not my will but thine be done." (Luke 22:42)

Question: Why let God fill us with His Spirit every day?

<u>Answer</u>: So that by our walk and our words, we can witness to the world that God exists and so people can come to know Him.

# VI. God Honors *Faith* When your Mountains Seem Impossible!

- "I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion." (v. 17)
- "The Lord shall deliver me from every evil work." (v. 18)
- "The Lord will preserve me unto His heavenly kingdom, to whom be glory forever and ever." (v. 18)

**Question**: What is Paul saying in his final words?

**Answer**: He is saying that he believes in the integrity and wisdom and <u>faithfulness</u> of God (regardless of how hopeless his circumstances appear.)

<u>Question</u>: Why is it God's will that you be filled with faith regardless of what you see in the natural?

Psalm 27:13 "I had fainted unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living."

#### In Other Words

- Paul in prison reminds us that at times God's work is invisible but God is working even when you <u>cannot see Him</u>. (And)
- We'll either exercise <u>faith</u> in our night seasons or we will experience <u>fainting</u> in those seasons. (It's either one or the other).
  - 1. What lions are you facing today?
  - 2. What mountains are before you today?
  - 3. Has someone or something broken your heart?
  - 4. Have you struggled to forgive someone that has hurt you?
  - 5. Encountered any unexplainable events in life? (Questions with no answers?)
  - 6. Battling any temptations on the inside?
  - 7. Fighting any demons of discouragement this hour because of unfulfilled expectations?

# God Has Good News For You

- He will stand with you and <u>strengthen</u> you to the degree that you live to do His will on earth!
- He will pour out His Spirit upon you to the degree that you humble yourself before Him.
- He will honor and favor you to the degree that your attitude and spirit are undefiled and transparent. (Void of all pretending)
