"THE MINISTRY OF PEARLS"

Matthew 13:45, 46

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls; who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it." (Matthew 13:45, 36)

Introduction

Question: How is the kingdom of heaven like a man seeking goodly pearls? **Answer**: Because Jesus gave up all that He had and bought us. (V. 46)

- 1. Jesus is the merchant man in Verse 45.
- 2. Jesus is seen leaving all to save one pearl.
- 3. Jesus was seeking pearls one day, and found you and me.
- 4. The pearl represents the believer.

(How are believers like pearls?) Some "Pearl Secrets"

I. Pearls Grow "Secretly"

Fact: No one can see the making of a pearl.

Fact: It is hidden in the oyster shell under the water.

Fact: The pearl may think that no one sees it (nor ever will).

(The Application – So We Are Like the Pearl)

- ◆ The shell that <u>hides the pearl</u> is the very thing that <u>forms its beauty</u>.
- ♦ The isolation, darkness and "alone time" are the very seasons God uses to **form the gems**.

Question: What do human pearls feel like when they are isolated in secret? (Psalm 142:4)

Question: What's the secret to victory when you have to walk "alone" for a season? (Ja.1:4)

Remember: "Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight; but all things are

naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do." (Heb. 4:13)

II. Pearls Grow "Slowly"

Fact: A gradual process must take place.

Fact: The pearl's schedule cannot be rushed.

Fact: The pearl's process is one of patience.

(The Application – So We Are Like The Pearl)

- Your schedule may be different than God's schedule.
- ♦ Humanity is prone to **impatience**.
- ♦ We can resent Good's timetable if not careful.

Question: What is patience, how is it developed and why is it an earmark of mature believers?

Remember: "He makes all things beautiful in His time." (Ecc 3:11)

III. Pearls Grow "Suffering"

Fact: The beautiful pearl is the result of injury.

Fact: A grain of sand gets within the shell of the oyster and injury is done to it.

Fact: That which it injures covers it over with NACRE layer over layer, until the pearl is formed.

(Application – So We Are Like the Pearl)

◆ The very <u>death</u> to self in you, is producing <u>life</u> for others.

♦ The very **pain** in you, will result in **fruit** to others.

◆ The very **injuries** to you, will be used by God to reveal His **grace** to others.

Question: How will seeing this process defeat the fiery darts of discouragement and

depression when tried by fire?

Remember: "So then death worketh in us, but life in you." (II Corinthians 4:12)

IV. Pearls Grow "Smoothly"

Fact: Any edges diminish the pearl's value.

Fact: Any pits or flaws reduce the pearl's beauty.

Fact: Unsmoothed pearls will cause them to be rejected and sidelined (until)

(Application - So We Are Like the Pearl)

- ♦ God will chisel **off the edges** with His tools.
- God will surface from within what needs to be filed off.
- ♦ God will use the <u>all things</u> of Romans 8:28 for His ultimate good.
- ◆ The devil will never show you the **end product** of God's smoothing process!!!

<u>Remember</u>: "Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness to do thee good at thy latter end." (Deuteronomy 8:16)

V. Pearls Grow "Selectively"

Fact: The word translated "pearl" is derived from a Sanskrit word with means "pure".

Fact: The pearl stands today suggesting purity.

Fact: This purity comes from the wounding of another.

(Application – So We Are Like the Pearl)

- ◆ Purity (Holiness/Wholeness) is our privilege as the result of **Christ's wounding**.
- God has designed us all to be pure and holy.
- ◆ God will (with our cooperation) **remove anything** that tarnishes His image in us.

<u>Remember</u>: "They that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts." (Galatians 5:24)

VI. Pearls Grow "Shielded"

Fact: The very shell that hems in the pearl is protecting it.

Fact: The very shell that squeezes it, is surrounding it.

Fact: The very pressure that keeps it inside, is the same pressure that keeps intruders out.

(The Application is Clear)

- ◆ God will keep His <u>pearls</u> in <u>safe keeping</u>.
- ◆ God will use outside **pressures** for His glory to **protect** you.
- God will use your **oysters** in life to **crowd you to himself** (so don't resent them).
- ◆ God help us to see life from **your perspective**.

Remember: "As for God, His way is perfect." (Psalm 18:30)

VII. Pearls Grow "Seasonally"

Fact: Pearls do not stay in oysters!

Fact: Pearls are not made for oysters.

Fact: Pearls are formed to "come out" and be displayed.

(Thank you Jesus)

- Never forget this, that everything in life is <u>seasonal</u>.
- ◆ Every <u>season</u> is always under <u>God's control</u> (not mans).
- ◆ There is always a proper **conclusion** to every single **trial** you will ever face.
- ◆ Your ultimate destination, purpose and glory is **never** in the hands of **mortal man**.

Man is just man. God is still God!!!

Remember: I Peter 1:6, 7 & 2 Corinthians 4:17, 18

P.S. "Lord, help us to remember when under water."

- 1. Our present field may be limited, but we are **not limited** by our field.
- 2. A bad attitude makes a person a **prisoner** of their own experience.
- 3. The root cause of all complaints is feeling that we are not getting what we **deserve**. The truth is, we don't want what really deserve.
- 4.Discouragement is a lie of the devil, to blind us in the **present** of what God is going to do in the **future**.
