(Message #8 - A Glorious Conclusion)

Text:

Revelation 1:17-20

Subject:

The Foundation Of All Joy And Power

Introduction

(For 7 Weeks We've Looked At Jesus In The Church)

Question: Who is revealing Himself?

Answer: Jesus is!

Question: Where is Jesus?

Answer: (Verse 13), "In the midst of the church".

Question: Why the revelation?

Answer: To show us what Jesus is doing. **Question:** What is Jesus doing in church?

Answer: He is building (your) life on the centrality of (His) life.

- #1. Jesus reveals His Robe (like the High Priest).
 - ♦ How He gives us access into the very presence of God.
- #2. Jesus reveals His *Hair* (as white as snow).
 - ♦ How He imparts His wisdom to those who follow Him.
- #3. Jesus reveals His **Eves** (as flames of fire).
 - ♦ How He exposes and purges away our sin.
- #4. Jesus reveals His Feet (of fine brass).
 - ♦ How He dominates the power of sin to control you any longer.
- #5. Jesus reveals His *Voice* (of thundering waters).
 - ♦ How He is still speaking and leading His own sheep.
- #6. Jesus reveals His *Hand* (of power).
 - ♦ How He holds you by His grace, strength and power.
- #7. Jesus reveals His Sword (of the Spirit).
 - ♦ How the mirror of the Word brings change to anyone who wants to change.

Question: How did John respond to the revelation of Jesus? **Answer:** The only way any of us would respond in verse 17:

"And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead" (In other words)

♦ When Jesus shows up – nobody struts!

Question: How did Jesus respond?

Answer: He lays His right hand upon John and says to John (what He says to you),

"Fear Not"

Question: Why doesn't John need to fear?

Question: What is it that comforts you and me?

Question: How does Jesus put a shout and a song upon every one that's here?

Question: What is all of our comfort based upon today?

Question: What does Jesus tell us that puts faith and courage and joy in all of us? (Pg. 1 of 4)

Question: What's the good news that puts a song in your heart and a shout on your lips?

Question: What's the Word that removes all fear?

(The Good News Is Found In 4 Revelations)

#1. Jesus Has Power Over "Time" (V. 17)

Question: How do we know that Jesus has power over time? **Answer:** In verse 17 He said, "I am the First and the Last"

- ♦ It's the first words following the command to John (and all of us to" fear not").
- ♦ Now its one thing to tell someone to "fear not",
- ♦ It's quite another thing to be able to show the reason to be of good cheer (and "fear not").

Question: What are Jesus' first words to John?

Answer: "I am the First and the Last".

Ouestion: What does it mean that Jesus is the First and the Last?

Answer: It means that Jesus has power over time.

- ♦ It refers to verse 8, "I am Alpha and Omega" (the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet).
- ♦ It means that Jesus is the beginning and the end (and overseeing everything in between).
- ♦ It means that Jesus was first-before anything else was ever created:

"In the beginning was the Word" (John 1:1)

♦ It means that Jesus will be in charge of the ending of it all. (He said:)

"This mortal shall put on immortality" (I Corinthians 15:53)

(In Other Words)

- #1. Psalm 31:15 says, "Your times are in His hands".
- #2. Psalm 37:23 says, "Your steps are ordered of the Lord".
- #3. Ecclesiastes 3:11 says, "He makes all things beautiful in His time".
- ♦ Beloved, you can rest well Jesus has power over time!

#2. Jesus Has Power Over "Life" (V. 18A)

Question: How do we know? (v. 18) "I am He that liveth"

Question: What is it that removes fear from the heart of every believer?

Answer: It is knowing that we serve a risen Savior and that Jesus really is alive!!!

- ♦ John called Jesus "Living Water". (John 4:10-11)
- ♦ John called Jesus "Living Bread". (John 6:51)
- ♦ Hebrews says Jesus **liveth** to make intercession for us. (7:25)

Question: How did Paul encourage Timothy just before Paul died?

Answer: He told Timothy this in II Timothy 2:8,

"Remember that Jesus Christ is risen and alive"

Question: What removed fear from Timothy's heart?

(Pg. 2 of 4)

Answer: Knowing that Jesus really is alive!

Question: How many of you know that Jesus really is alive today?

"I serve a risen Savior, He's in the world today, I know that He is living, whatever men may say, I see His hand of mercy, I hear His voice of cheer, and just the time I need Him, He's always near. He lives, He lives, Christ Jesus lives today:

Question: How can this be?

Answer: Because Jesus is alive and well!

(Today)

"If our circumstances find us in God, we will find God in all our circumstances" (Why?)

• Because Jesus is alive, (He really is alive).

#3. Jesus Has Power Over "Sin" (V. 18A)

"Was dead...but am alive forevermore".

Question: How do we know this?

Answer: Because Jesus refers here to His historical victory over sin which causes death.

(In Other Words)

Jesus says, "I was dead"

Question: Why did Jesus die?

Answer: Jesus died to appease the wrath of God against our sin!

(In Other Words)

- ◆ We all sinned and were guilty.
- We all sinned and were condemned.
- We all sinned and were sentenced.

(But In Death – Jesus Conquered Sin)

(Which Means:)

- ♦ Jesus broke sin's power to rule you any longer if you know Jesus!
- ♦ Jesus broke sin's power to force you to be a slave to your carnal nature!
- ♦ Jesus broke sin's power to keep you under the domain of satan!
- ♦ Jesus broke sin's power by becoming our payment in full!
- ♦ Jesus broke sin's power that led to Jesus' death in the first place!

(In Other Words)

Be encouraged and shout with victory. (Why?)

- ♦ Because Jesus was dead (Yes) because of sin.
- ♦ But now Jesus lives because sin's power had been broken for those who are in Christ.

"Amen, and have the keys of hell and of death"

Question: What does Jesus tell John?

Answer: "I have the keys".

Question: What are keys for?

Answer: Keys are for opening locked doors!

Question: What two doors did Jesus open?

Answer: (Verse 18)

#1. "I have the keys of hell" (And)

#2. "I have the keys of death"

(In Other Words)

"Fear not John and be of good cheer!!!"

#1. "I've delivered you from death so you too will live always", (And)

#2. "I've delivered you from hell and the judgment to come upon the unsaved".

(In Other Words)

- ♦ You have everything to live for!
- ♦ You have everything to look forward to!
- ♦ You have all your past sins covered!
- ◆ You have nothing to fear as you age!
- ♦ You have nothing to worry about when you physically die!
- ♦ You have not a worry in the world that I have not already addressed!

In II Timothy 1:10, "Jesus Christ has abolished death"

In Hebrews 2:14, "Jesus destroyed him who had the power of death"

In Revelation 21:4, "And there shall be no more death, or pain, or crying or tears"

In John 5:24, "You've passed from death unto life"

In John 14:19, "Because I live, you shall live also"

"Fear Not Everyone"

- #1. I have power over *Time!*
- #2. I have power over Life!
- #3. I have power over Sin!
- #4. I have power over **Death**, **Hell** and the **Grave!**
