"THE MAKING OF SILVER"

Psalm 66:1-20

"For thou, O God, hast proved us; thou hast tried us, as silver is tried." (v. 10)

— INTRODUCTION —

- Psalm 66 is a powerful song of praise to be sung. (Written out of gratefulness to God)
- The composer has been delivered from personal testing.
- The writer is ecstatic over God's faithful intervention. (Listen to his praise:)

"We went through fire and we went through water, but you Lord brought us out into a wealthy place. (v. 12)

Fact: In verse 11, God brings us in.

(Sovereignty)

Fact: In verse 12a, God brings us through. (Sustains)

Fact: In verse 12b, God brings us out.

(Solution)

And God always brings us out different than when we go in. (It's bitter or better.)

3 Absolutes That Minister Today

I. God Is Great In *POWER* (v. 1-9)

Question:

Why are we told to praise the Lord in verses 1-5?

Answer:

Because of His active ministry in our lives.

#1. God Turns

He turned the sea into dry land; they went through the flood on foot. (v. 6) Two Miracles:

- 1. The Red Sea (when God brought Israel out of Egypt)
- 2. The River of Jordan (when God brought Israel into the promised land.

In Other Words ...

- There is not one obstacle or power of darkness that can hold you in Egypt (a type of the world and sin).
- There is not one River of Jordan that can keep you from possessing what God intends for you to have.

God Sees #2.

"His eyes behold the nations" (v. 7)

Fact: God sees exactly where you are today!

Fact: God knows exactly what you are facing!

Fact: God's plan for you cannot be thwarted!

#3. God Holds

"Which holdeth our soul in life and suffereth not our feet to be moved" (v. 9)

Question: What does it mean that God holds our soul and suffereth not out feet to

be moved?

Answer: Holds our soul means: That God preserves us in the midst of any extreme

trial that seeks to crush our spirit.

<u>Suffers not our feet to be moved</u> means: That the Lord will keep you firm and in place through every trial and season of life.

II. God Is Great In *PURGING* (v. 10)

Question: Why did God allow the psalmist to be taken into the Babylonian captivity?

Question: Why did God allow the affliction and fire of verses 11 & 12?

Answer: To prove us and try us as silver is tried.

In Other Words

• The Lord tried Israel to test their allegiance to Him.

- The Lord tested Israel to prove her loyalty to Him.
- The Lord purified Israel as silver in the fire.

Silver Is Purified By Fire

- "I will bring them through the fire and refine them as silver" (Zechariah 13:9)
- "He shall be as a refiner's fire and purifier of silver" (Malachi 3:3)
- "Take away the dross from the silver, and there shall come forth a vessel for the finer" (Proverbs 25:4)

4 Silver Secrets

- 1. Refined silver requires just the right care. (Deuteronomy 32:10-14)
- 2. Refined silver requires just the right furnace. (I Peter 1:6) (Not just any oven will do.)
- 3. Refined silver requires just the right heat. (I Corinthians 10:13)

(The silversmith never neglects the thermostat)

- If it's too cold, the base metals will not separate from silver.
- If it's too hot, portions of silver will be carried off with the impure lead.
- 4. Refined silver requires just the right timing. (Psalm 31:15)

The smith knows when to take the metal out of the heat.

III. God Is Great In PROVIDENCE (v.11-16)

Question: Who was it that allowed Israel to be taken hostage into Babylon?

Question: Who was it that used a wicked king to fulfill God's purpose in Israel?

"Thou brought us into the net, laid affliction upon our loins and caused men to ride over our heads" (v. 11, 12)

Fact: It was by God's design that we went through the fire.

<u>Fact:</u> It was by God's appointment for our inconvenience.

<u>Fact:</u> It was by God's permission that Israel was tried as silver is tried.

Never Forget

- God is in control and "works all things after the counsel of His own will". (Ephesians 1:11)
- God is preparing you for something greater than before your fire. (Hebrews 12:11)
- God is producing fruit in every season that seems painful to you. (John 15:2)

What's The Secret To Survival?

1. Integrity of character. (v. 13-16)

3. Purity of heart. (v. 18)

2. Humility of spirit. (v. 17)

4. Dependability in prayer. (v. 19, 20)

"When God has tried me I shall come forth as gold" (Job 23:10)
