

Question: Is peace that important to God?

1. "But the fruit of the Spirit is **peace**" (Galatians 5:22)

- 2. "Therefore being justified by faith, we have <u>peace</u> with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1)
- 3. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect <u>peace</u> whose mind is stayed on thee, because he trusteth in thee" (Isaiah 26:3)
- 4. "Grace be unto you, and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ" (Phil. 1:2)
- 5. "For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink, but righteousness, and <u>peace</u> and joy in the Holy Ghost" (Romans 14:17)
- 6. "The Lord will give strength unto His people, the Lord will bless His people with peace" (Ps. 29:11)
- 7. "I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep; for thou Lord only makest me dwell in safety" (Ps.4:8)
- 8. "Acquaint now thyself with him, and be at peace: Thereby good shall come unto thee" (Job 22:21)
- 9. "And His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of <u>Peace</u>" (Isaiah 9:6)
- 10. "For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace" (Romans 8:6)
- 11. "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have <u>peace</u>. In the world ye shall have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world" (John 16:33)
- 12. "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you; not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (John 14:27)
- 13. "Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and **peace** in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost" (Romans 15:13)
- 14. "Peace be with you all that are in Christ Jesus (I Peter 5:14)
- 15: "Follow peace with all men and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord" (Heb. 12:14)

(And Finally In Romans 12:18)

◆ "If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men".

"Don't quarrel with anyone; be at peace with everyone"

Question: What is peace?

The word peace (EIRENE) means six things:

1. Rest 2. Order 3. Harmony 4. Security 5. Tranquil

(Peace Is:)

- 1...Tranquility in your inner man because of God's presence in your life.
- 2...Security in the midst of turmoil; the eye in the middle of the storm.
- 3...That assurance given us by God, that He is in control and over all that touches you.
- 4...The fruit which gives order, rest and harmony to you on the inside.
- 5...That quality of God's nature imparted to a believer who is yielded and surrendered to the Holy Spirit's control.

(Many Look For Peace In)

- ◆ But the peace of God that passes all understanding can only be found in the Lord!
- ◆ It is the byproduct, or fruit, or reward of someone who is in right relationship with God.

What Is A Peacemaker? I.

"Blessed are the peacemakers" (v. 9)

◆ The word "peacemaker" here comes from the Greek word (EIRENOPOIOS) Which means:

#1. To bring together

#6. To eliminate strife

#2. To pursue harmony

#7. To silence criticism

#3. To resolve disputes

#8. To set at rest

#4. To erase division

#9. To make peace with God

#5. To reconcile differences

#10. To build right relationships

6. Quietness

Ouestion: How many of you believe it is a good idea to be in right relationship with God (and

people)?

Question: How many of you know that it is God's plan for you to "get along" with your spouse,

your parents, your children, your employer, your deacon and your neighbors?

Ouestion: How many of you haven't tore out of your Bible - 2 Timothy 2:24 "Refuse to quarrel and contend, but preserve the bond of peace".

Illustration

- One day a little boy was picking on his sister and his sister ran to her mother crying.
- ♦ Mom said, "Honey what's wrong?"
- ♦ The little girl said, "Johnny told me I was ugly".
- ♦ Mom said, "Johnny, tell your sister you're sorry".
- ◆ Johnny said, "Ok, Sissy; I'm sorry you're ugly".

(That's not how to preserve the bond of peace)

- #1. A peacemaker is someone who pursues harmony.
- #2. A peacemaker is someone who erases division.
- #3. A peacemaker is someone who silences criticism.
- #4. A peacemaker is someone who eliminates strife.
- #5. A peacemaker is someone who reconciles differences.
- #6. A peacemaker is someone who resolves disputes.
- #7. A peacemaker is someone who buries the hatchet.
- ◆ Peacemakers practice Matthew 5: 23 24

"So if you offer your gift at the altar and remember that your brother has something against you; leave your gift beside the altar and go make peace with your brother, and then come and offer your gift".

(In Other Words)

◆ It is more important to God that your heart be clean and your relationships be right (than it is for you to give a million dollars in the offering).

II. How Can You Be A New Testament Peacemaker?

(James has the answer) James 3:13-4:2

- 1. James here contrasts what is peaceable to what is contentious.
- 2. He shows us the root cause of visible behavior we've all seen.
- 3. We have before us a revelation of two sources that produce two different kinds of fruit.
- 4. It is a picture of a healthy person (and an unhealthy person).
- 5. It is a "Plain vanilla" list of what <u>blocks</u> and (what promotes) a peaceable spirit inside of us all.

First: James reveals 2 traits of the Wise (v. 13)

- #1. "Good Behavior" (which refers to someone going back to the truth to change and conform to that truth).
- #2. "Meekness of Wisdom" (Which is someone gentle and not out of control)

(2 Traits Of The Unwise Are): (Verse 14)

Trait #1. Strife (which means "party spirit".)

- ◆ It is the word used by the Greeks to describe a politician canvassing for votes.
- ◆ It means to "Canvas" for your cause even if it causes strife, division and contention.

Trait #2. Deceit (V. 14 "Lie not against the truth" (Means:)

- ◆ To deceive other people for the purpose of promoting yourself.
- ◆ It means; devilish wisdom is revealed by the fruit of contention (as opposed to peacefulness).

(In Other Words)

◆ God is the author of peace and gentleness! ◆ Satan is the author of strife and division!

The Question Is: How Can You Be A Peacemaker?

(By avoiding 5 traps in James 3:14-18)

- ◆ 5 things to avoid like the plague.
- ◆ 5 traps of satan that produce contention inside of you (and outside).
- ◆ 5 seeds that produce a harvest of death, war and unrest within.

(Write Down These) 5 Killers Of A Peacemaker

- #1. Guilt: Which causes you to justify past actions (instead of repenting of them).
- #2. Bitterness: Which is reacting because of personal hurts (that will poison your spirit).
- #3. Envy: Which desires what someone else has, and is disturbed because he can't have it.
- #4. Rebellion: Which is an independent spirit that resists submission to God.
- #5. Pride: Which wants to exalt itself and have its own way.

The Opposite Of These 5 (Will allow you to be at peace inwardly and a peacemaker outwardly)

(5 Roots Of A Peacemaker)

- #1. Instead of guilt (freedom) because you repent of sin and refuse to justify it.
- #2. Instead of bitterness (forgiveness) because you know that God has forgiven you of all.
- #3. Instead of envy (contentment) because God is enough for you to enjoy what you have.
- #4. Instead of rebellion (submission) because you know that God's way is better than your way.
- #5. Instead of pride (humility) because you know that God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.
- #1. The Cause (V. 16)
 - ◆ The word "Confusion" means "Disorder"
 - ◆ It means disorderly (un-peaceful) people reveal the cause is disorder on the inside.
- #2. The Choice (V. 17)
 - "Without hypocrisy" means: Refusing to wear a mask and pretend to be something outwardly that you are not inwardly.
 - ♦ It is my choice "Not to pretend" that allows me to pray through and be cleansed.
- #3. The Calm (V. 18)

"The fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace" (Means:)

- ◆ If we refuse the 5 enemies of peace, we will reap peace inwardly, (and)
- ◆ Then we can sow peace into other people.

Remember:

- ◆ It is injured people who injure others, (and)
- ◆ It is peaceful people who sow peace to others.

III. What Is The Reward Of A Peacemaker?

"Blessed are the peacemakers, (why?) for they shall be called the children of God" (v. 9)

Question: What does it mean to "be called the children of God?"

Answer: The word "called" means "owned". (It means that...)

- #1...Peacemakers are children of God because they resemble their Heavenly Father.
- #2...Peacemakers are children of God because they repeat what God has done (in making peace through the blood of His cross).
- #3...Peacemakers are children of God because they resolve the internal issues in their own life that disturb their peace.
- #4...Peacemakers are children of God because they humble themselves enough before Father, so that God can change what needs to be changed.
- #5...Peacemakers are children of God because they have submitted themselves to God's authority (as a child would wisely to their parents authority).

(Pg. 4 of 5)

Peacemakers have died to stubbornness,

♦ Peacemakers have died to resistance,

◆ Peacemakers have died to self-preoccupation.

◆ Peacemakers have died to their way (so they can submit to God's way).

Question: Have you done that? **Question:** Do you need to do that?

Question: Will you do that?

Question: Will you make peace with God so that you can be a peacemaker for God?

"Pastor, I'm in need of peace and I want to be a peacemaker - what do I do?

(James 4:7-8)

#1. Submit To God (V.7)

(Hold no area back or you'll be miserable)

#2. Resist The Devil (V. 7)

(Or give him "no foothold" to work from at all)

#3. Draw Closer To God (V. 8)

(Through confession, cleansing and purifying our hearts).

Altar Call...

Question: Is there any quilt from sin that robs you of the peace of God?

Question: Is there any stubbornness on the inside that is causing you trouble on the outside?

Question: Have you been blaming someone else for what is inside of you?

Question: Are you willing to submit your will to God and be internally changed?

Question: Will you allow the Spirit, to take the Word, and minister life saving surgery?
